8 Einar Jónsson Art museum The sculpture garden behind the Einar Jónsson Art Museum is open all year round, entrance is free and it is a popular site to visit in whatever season.



9 Hallgrímskirkja "Hallgrim's Church" in Reykjavik is the tallest and most striking church in Iceland.



10 Eldsmiðjan Pizza baked in a wood-fired oven, take away or eat in.

11 Café Loki Traditional Icelandic homemade dishes such as Icelandic meat soup, bread and cakes.



12 Krambúð A small supermarket open 24/7.
